Approximately 30 of the Carnegie Institution's users will access Serenic Navigator Advanced Management Edition – certified for Microsoft Dynamics NAV – as well as other applications within the Navigator extended product suite, including web portals, AwardVision grant management software, DonorVision and Human Capital Management.
